**Year-end Report Card**  
**District 65 Performances - 2005-2006**

Based on information received from TI as of June 29<sup>th</sup>, 2006, the following are the achievements of members, clubs, areas and divisions in district 65. There will be a final adjustment done to the numbers on or by July 24, and we may receive additional awards.
