We also need people to fill roles (TM, chief eval, timer, ah counter/grammarian). These roles will change each hour. If people are interested in these and want to do them for credit towards CL, please let us know so we can schedule an evaluator.

You must pre-register to ensure a speaking slot.

Every speech must be a prepared speech that counts toward an educational goal. Every speech will be given a written evaluation.

There will be a maximum of 2 speeches permitted per person. Every speaker must provide a written evaluation for someone else.

There will be a Walk-in Waiting List for those who want to speak but are not sure they can make it to the event OR if guaranteed slots fill up. Walk-ins will be accommodated if time permits AND prior request has been made to be put on the waiting list. Walk-ins do not have to sign up for a specific time slot.
